Soprafina Gallery is pleased to announce our fifth solo exhibition of Nona Hershey's new work.

Nona Hershey's new series of work, *Viewpoints*, is a creative visualization of what we cannot see in our atmosphere. There are 19 new pieces included in this current exhibition. Her medium is mostly watercolor, graphite powder and gouache on paper.

Nona Hershey has studied and taught worldwide having lived in Rome for 20 years where she also served as Assistant Professor of Printmaking at the Tyler School of Art and also at Temple University's Tokyo program for one year. Since September 1993, Ms. Hershey has been Professor and Coordinator of the Printmaking Department at Massachusetts College of Art in Boston.

Nona Hershey's work is included in numerous public collections worldwide, including the Metropolitan Museum of Art, NY; Museum of Fine Arts, Boston; Library of Congress; Fogg Art Museum; Yale University Art Gallery; Crakow National Museum; the Calcongrafia Nazionale, Rome to mention an abbreviated list. She has received residency grants at the Asillah Forum Foundation, Morocco; the Ballinglen Arts Foundation, Ireland; the Ucross Foundation, WY; Massachusetts Cultural Council Grant; Virginia Center for the Creative Arts; Vermont Studio Center and twice at the MacDowell Colony, NH. .
